
Naipunya Vikasam Program

Program framework

Schoolnet India Ltd. is a training partner of the Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC) and Andhra Pradesh Schools Program for Innovation, Research and Excellence (ASPIRE) for imparting English and Life Skills to the students of Social Welfare and Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The program is designed to improve functional English language skills and psychosocial competency to enable students to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life. As an implementation partner Schoolnet has:

covered under the project






Naipunya Vikasam program reaches out to students of 5 to 12 grade at 427 Social Welfare & Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions:

An impact assessment exercise covered 100 of these schools to gather feedback on program implementation and student outcomes. A total of 100 Principals, 191 Teachers, 91 ELS Trainers, 848 students, and 10 Government Officials were interviewed. In addition, 1,120 students of Grades 5-8 were assessed at intervention schools and 256 students were assessed at comparison schools for their English language proficiency and life skills. The results of the impact assessment exercise are promising.




Principals' Satisfaction with the Naipunya Vikasam Program



Principals expressed satisfaction about the initiative ELS Trainers took for the effective implementation of the program and found the program highly relevant to the needs of the students







Many (>85%) students surveyed found English and Life Skills Sessions helpful on multiple parameters:





Student Proficiency in English: Naipunya Vikasam Program versus Comparison Group













Students of grades 5-8 in the Program Group out-performed their counterparts on all the four domains of English Language Development-listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.



Student Proficiency in English: Naipunya Vikasam Program versus Comparison Group





Students (Grade 5-8) from the Program Group performed better compared to the students from Comparison Groups in identifying resources available to them. This ability is likely to help students maximise resources available to them and seek timely support from people known to them in case of any challenges they face. Program Group students also out-performed Comparison Group students in identifying solutions to the challenges presented.
